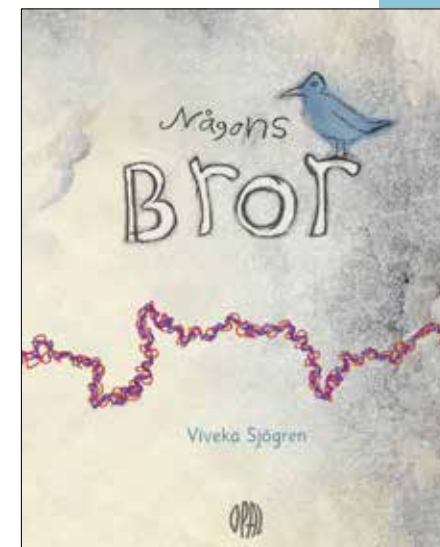
Someone's Brother

The first book about Pettson and Findus, *Pannkakstårtan*, was published in 1984 and has stayed popular ever since. The book has, until today, sold over 3,6 million copies around the world. 30 years later the first board book was published, *Känner du Pettson och Findus?* and has so far sold almost 300 000 copies. The entire series has been a success right from the start, both in Sweden and around the world. All together they have sold approximately 20 million copies and have been translated into 62 languages.

All the books have been highly welcomed, but the three most popular Pettson-books around the world is *Pannkakstårtan*, *Pettson får julbesök* and *När Findus var liten och försvann*.
